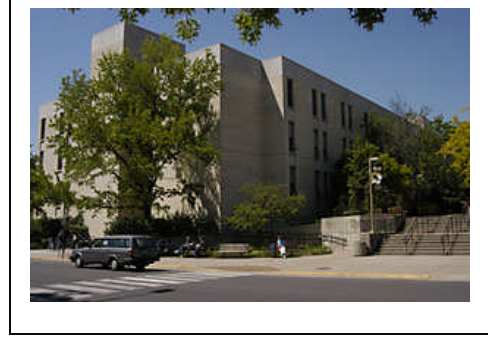

1. If coming in via I-70 W OR coming in on Hwy 63 from the north or south
2. Take I-70 West.
3. Take exit 128 on the left for I-70 Bus Loop toward Columbia
4. Slight right at Business Loop 70 E/I-70 Bus Loop
5. Turn left at N College Ave/MO-763
6. Turn right at E Rollins St/Rosemary Ln
7. Continue to follow E Rollins St to Rollins St & Missouri Ave
